

Sage Creek Elementary
Community Council Minutes
December 4, 2018

Members in attendance: Principal Alison Hansen, Leslie Ewell, Kelli Giles, Sydney Condie, Julie Graves, and Stacy Uriona. Excused from meeting were Dewey Houston, and Ashlee Clark.

Minutes from November 6, Community Council meeting were reviewed. Member Julie Graves proposed to accept, and Stacy Uriona gave the second.

During the November meeting it was suggested that we look at the budget along with the School Improvement Plan side by side. Although goal #1 was reviewed and discussed, it requires the majority of Trustlands money. Time was allotted to again review and revise Goal #1 with the proposed budget. The Summer Reading program, 2 literacy aides, the 1/2 salary of a teacher, as well as the upkeep of the Leveled Library is approximately \$57,200 of the \$73,800 budget.

In preparation for DIBELS testing, Mrs. Hansen and Mrs. Ewell meet with K-3rd grade teachers to review DIBELS scores. Teachers received training in DIBELS to help support students in their academic reading goals. Each grade has been given a grade level goal to work towards.

The question was raised of "Are parents aware of their child's testing results, and where can parents find this information?" Most grade levels hand delivered and discussed the testing results with parents at the first S.E.P conference. However, all testing results are found on the students' SIS account. The possible solution would be that before S.E.P conferences teachers will send an email explaining the testing.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:25 p.m. The next Community Council meeting will be held on January 8, 2019. At this time the School Improvement Plan and budget for Goal #2 will be addressed.
