4. Pam Turley- Internet Safety- Nebo District Digital Coach Pam Turley presented school safety and digital citizenship to the Community Council. Defining Digital citizenship the norms of appropriate, responsible, and healthy behavior related to technology use, including digital literacy, ethics, etiquette, and security. Safety principles are defined as principles that strengthen safe and wholesome learning environments when incorporated into programs and resources at the school. Utah Code 53G-7-1202(1)(a)  
  
Nebo School District has adopted two online programs to supplement teaching in math (iReady) and reading (Lexia). For both programs to be successful, blended learning would be required. Blended learning is where both programs are used by the teacher and the technicians. Teachers can receive immediate feedback as the child completes learning activities.
