March 6, 2018

The School Improvement Plan and Trustlands Budget go together, each one supporting the other. As a council we chose to look at these items together to determine our greatest needs.

Mrs. Hansen provided the council with a budget summary of 2016-17 and years of 2017-18. This was very helpful due to the new Community Council Members that are serving their first term this year. As the previous years' budget was reviewed a proposed 2018-19 budget was formed.

2018-19 Proposal:

\$33,000	1/2 teacher
\$26,000	Aides- 4 aides, 2 for literacy and 2 for math support... approx. \$6,600/aide
\$ 5,000	Summer reading program
\$ 4, 000	Automate leveled library for teachers-books in computer system
\$ 3,400	Technology
\$ 1,500	Conferences, professional development
\$ 500	Substitutes for professional development

After having a great discussion the committee signed off on the 2018-2019 Budget proposal.

Due to the time spent on the Budget, the School Improvement plan will be discussed at the April 10, Community Council meeting.

Sage Creek received the results of the Stake Holder Survey. The main two issues that parents mentioned the most 1) Thank you for allowing the students in the building during the winter 2) Science Fair for 3 years is too much.
