

Sage Creek Elementary
Community Council Minutes
November 6, 2018

All members were in attendance for the November 6, Community Council meeting at Sage Creek Elementary.

As members, it was decided that it would be proactive to review one goal of the School Improvement Plan each month. This allows time for each goal to be reviewed, analyzed, and/or changed.

Language Arts Goal

Goal 1: Quality Language Arts Instruction

The percent of students in grades 1-3 performing on grade level or making typical progress in DIBELS will improve from 81% to 84%.

The percent of students in grades 4-6 performing on grade level or making typical progress on SAGE Language Arts will improve from 72% to 75%.

Nebo Goal (Board Goal) Connections: Elementary Reading, Teacher Evaluation

- Third grade students' reading proficiency will continue to exceed the current state standard and improve annually at the school level according to the DIBELS assessment.*
- 100% of certified employees will be evaluated annually.*

The DIBELS measurement for grades 1-3 decreased to 78% of our students either proficient or making adequate progress. The SAGE measurement for grades 4-6 decreased to 66% of our students either proficient or making adequate progress. Reading benchmarks are administered to each student at Sage Creek and 74% of our students were reading on grade level or above at the end of the school year.

While we are disappointed in our assessment results, we followed the goal with fidelity and are confident in the instruction our students received. We will continue to monitor and adjust where needed. As a committee, we feel that this goal is imperative to the success of our students. The only change that will be made is the name of the End of level assessment for grades 4-6. It is no longer called SAGE.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:25 p.m. The next Community Council meeting will be held on December 4, 2018. At this time the School Improvement Plan, Goal #2 will be addressed.
