1. Attendance: All members were in attendance
 2. Review of Oct minutes: Dewey Houston nominated to accept October minutes, Sydney Condie second.
 3. Review of meeting with Superintendent Nielsen: Mr. Nielsen reviewed the Middle school purpose and model. Boundaries of the new upcoming schools were also discussed in the meeting.
 4. Budget: The discussion of the "Actual budget 2018-2019-Total Spent" was led by Mrs. Hansen. She explained the purpose of where the Trust land monies were spent and the benefits for each. The budget for 2019-2020 was reviewed per the conversation in February's SCC meeting. If the Trustland money increased the committee agreed to put any extra money towards aides and/or professional development.
 5. Safe Walking Route: Postponed until March meeting.
 6. Internet Safety: Postponed until March meeting.
- ❖ Other items: Two new programs were introduced to Sage Creek students the beginning of this year. The new math program that was adopted by Nebo District is i-Ready. Each student was given a math diagnostic. The data that was collected helps teachers understand what students know and don't know. This helps to meet the wide-range on student needs, and fosters student ownership of learning and growth. The new reading program is entitled "Lexia Core5 Reading." It also required students to take a reading diagnostic. The goals of Lexia are to give teachers access to real-time student data to plan instruction, and to help determine how to enhance student learning with instructional resources. Both of these programs require a diagnostic 3 times a year to evaluate student learning.
