❖ Attendance: Principal Alison Hansen, Jennifer Grant, Kelli Giles, Julie Wood, Sydney Condie, Dewey Houston, Stacy Uriona, Amanda Smith, and Rhianna Parkinson were all in attendance for this Jan meeting.

❖ Sidewalk proposal: Ms. Hansen shared with the council the sidewalk grant from UDOT was funded partially (the biggest majority was funded) and Springville City would cover the difference. The sidewalk will be constructed once funds are (schedule to be) available July 2022. The sidewalk will be on 1355 S and cover between 400 E and 700 E. The council is thrilled at the idea and Ms. Hansen reiterated what the city had - the project would not have been granted without all of their letters of support. A great job to all on the council!

❖ The budget for 2021-22 school year was approved. The council recognizes funds may be reduced because of 6th gr leaving, but Mr. Johnson, the new principal, could consider the council's goals and perhaps use TSSA funds to cover what isn't covered here. The funds are listed in prioritized order so, depending on what the final budget bottom line may be, adjustments can be made accordingly.

- \$35,000 ½ FTE
- \$ 2,000 Prof development (\$1500 conf fees, \$500 subs)
- \$33,500 4 aides for tier 2 intervention
- \$ 8,000 Summer reading/math - need 6 teachers/aides total
- \$ 3,000 Lev Library upkeep - a summer aide
- \$ 4,000 Technology - chromebooks and/or iPads

If additional funds:

- \$1700 Classroom speaker system (audio enhancement) for Library

- \$1200 Aide to open school library for one morning a week
