Additionally, Mrs. Hansen asked how things were going with coming back to school. Overall, the council felt as though things were going well and their kids were enjoying school. Having a shortened lunch was mentioned, some kids feeling like they don't have enough time to eat. We discussed how lunch is our most

vulnerable time, kids are without masks and we simply don't have the space to distance so we are keeping the kids together under 15 minutes. We talked about how this is the same amount of time kids had last year, but the difference is instead of having all kids wait until they are excused, they are invited to leave as soon as they finish eating. This feels like there isn't as much time because kids are getting up to leave and the slower eaters are not finishing because they want to go out with their friends. We talked about how we encourage students to "eat, eat, eat" when in the cafeteria and visit with their friends outside and we do have the ability to make accommodations for our slower eaters and have been doing so, but usually the problem is the kids themselves feeling like they want to get outside.
