1. **Attendance:** Stacy Uriona was excused from today's meeting.
 2. **Review of Oct minutes:** Dewey Houston nominated that we accept the October minutes, and Amanda Smith second.
 3. **Welcome New Member:** Rhianna Parkinson- Rhianna has 5 children, sales real-estate, and from New York. She is honored to serve as a Community Council Member.
 4. **Budget:** Trustlands monies are to be used for the greatest academic needs of Sage Creek Elementary students. The budget for the 2020-2021 school year has already been approved. The members will be working on the 2021-2022 school year. Trustlands money is given to schools based on its population. Due to natural attrition Sage Creek lost about 75 students leaving the student body at 675 pupils. These numbers will also change next year when the 6th grade is moved to the Middle School.
 5. **Safe Walking Route: Up-date:** Mrs. Alison Hansen has been working with the city for a number of summers due to no sidewalk. Many community members wrote letters to the city to show concern for the Sage Creek students that have to walk to school using that route. Springville City is now looking into the project, and hopes to have it started in 2023.
