Safety Reminders

As we start a new school year, it's a good idea to review some safety items:

- * Please do not park and leave your car in the drop-off / pick-up lane in front of the school. It causes traffic to back up and increases safety issues for students. If you need to come into the school, please park on the opposite side of the street or in the parking lot.
- * We would also ask that you please do not call your child over to your car from across the street. This is very dangerous due to the large amount of traffic at the end of the day. Please encourage your child to use the crosswalk.
- * The bus lane is only to be used by Nebo School District buses. Please do not use the bus lane before or after school.

- * School begins at 9:15 with teachers arriving at 8:45. Thank you for not sending your child to school before 8:45 as there is not adequate supervision at this time.
- * Now is a great time to review safe walking routes and procedures with your child if they walk to and from school each day. It's also a good idea to visit with your child about not going anywhere after school except to their home/sitter. Students often make arrangements with friends at school without telling their parents and this causes worry on your end as well as ours.
